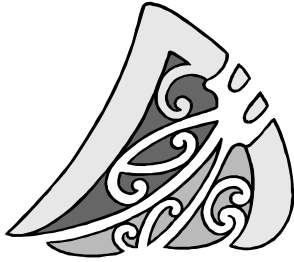
### **CRITERIA**

- Applicants need to be aged 17 to 20, and achieving outstanding results at regional, national or international level
- The scholarship is to the value of \$5,000.
- The successful candidate will be required to be available for a one-off marketing or presentation exercise to the CEO and/or Board of Skills Active and send regular updates of their progress.
- The CEO & management of Skills Active, and the CEO of Te Tohu Taakaro o Aotearoa Charitable Trust, will make the final selection.

### **PROCESS**

- Closing date for receiving applications is Friday 26 October 2012. No late applications will be accepted.
- All applicants will be notified of the successful applicant.
- The successful applicant will be required to attend the National Māori Sports Awards ceremony at the TelstraClear Pacific Events Centre, Manukau on Saturday 1 December 2012, and will be assisted with the costs of travel and accommodation.
